



ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

- ✍ Attendance at Troop meetings, Parent Nights/Courts of Honor or outings is not mandatory. However, if a Scout cannot attend a Troop meeting or a Parent Night/Court of Honor, the Scout must notify either his Patrol Leader or any Adult Leader at least one hour before the event. Failure to attend the meeting or function without notification will be recorded as an inexcusable absence. A Scout who does call, however and for any reason, will be recorded with an excusable absence.
- ✍ For a Scout to be eligible to attend a Troop outing, campout, hike, etc., a Scout must be in attendance or excusably absent for the three consecutive meetings before the outing.
- ✍ Missing Troop meetings or Parent Nights/Courts of Honor without notification:
 1. Two meetings in a row will result in the Scout discussing his absence with the Patrol Leaders Council and the Adult Leaders.
 2. For the second offense of missed meetings, a letter will be sent to the Parent(s) who will be asked, along with the Scout, to discuss the matter with the Adult Leaders.
 3. For the third offense of missed meetings, the Scout will be suspended from attending any Troop outings for three months.
 4. Continued absence will be cause for dismissal from the Troop.
- ✍ All Scouts are expected to be in attendance and to contribute to all Troop fund raising projects to the minimum requirements set for the event. Failure to participate in the function without notifying an Adult Leader will result in the Scout being prohibited from attending the next Troop outing as well as the following month's progress toward rank review.
- ✍ Attendance and dues record keeping is the responsibility of the Troop Scribe.
