



BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

The SCOUT OATH and SCOUT LAW are the prevailing guidelines for all Scouts!

- ✍ Smoking by Scouts is strongly discouraged and will not be allowed at any Troop activity or outing. Violations will result in:

1st Offense: Warning by Adult Leaders

2nd Offense: Letter to Parent(s) requesting meeting and discussion

3rd Offense: Dismissal from Troop

- ✍ Use of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed. Use of either will result in:

1st Offense: Meeting with the Scout's Parent(s)

2nd Offense: Dismissal from Troop

- ✍ Stealing offenses will result in a meeting with the Scout's Parent(s), followed by dismissal from the Troop.

- ✍ Excessive or continued discipline problems, such as fighting, bullying, cursing and name calling, unruly behavior, excessive arguments or noncooperation, etc., etc. as determined by events or complaints from Troop members will be dealt with in the following manner:

1st Warning: Appearance before the Patrol Leaders Council

2nd Warning: Appearance before Adult Leaders

3rd Warning: Appearance of Scout's Parent(s) before the Patrol Leaders Council and Adult Leaders.

4th Warning: Suspension from Troop or Dismissal from Troop

- ✍ Troop meeting space, equipment, books, magazines, supplies, etc. shall be dealt with responsibly. Abuse, misuse or loss or damage to Troop property, your property, will be dealt with on an individual basis by the Patrol Leaders Council or by the Troop Adult Leaders. Fines, suspension from Troop activities or dismissal may be administered for serious infractions of this guideline.
